TOUR-DE-FOREST

ATV Ride & Prize Run

Bring yourself and your family for a day or weekend filled with fun on:

May 22 & 23 2010

Enjoy a leisurely, scenic ride on specially designated trails in cooperation with the Allegheny National Forest that consists of five interlocking loops with an outside perimeter that is approximately 65 miles and a total of approximately 90 miles.

The Tour-De-Forest is only affiliated with locations marked on the map.

A \$40.00 registration fee covers a two (2) day ride, one (1) all-you-can-eat breakfast, one (1) lunch, and two (2) tickets for the prize run.

A \$30.00 registration fee covers a one (1) day ride, and one (1) ticket for the prize run.

Additional activities may include: Prize run giveaway, ATV wash, all-you-can-eat breakfast, dealer displays, food stands along the trail.

* All double riders must follow PA DMV codes. Any child 8 years of age and under may only ride in a class 2 ATV.

* Passengers 8 years of age and older may ride on a class 1 ATV only with a approved after market seat.

* All machines must meet all Pennsylvania state laws, hold a valid registration and insurance from a state recognized by Pennsylvania.

* There is a 25 MPH speed limit.

* Riders ages 8 to 15 must hold a valid safety certificate.

* Riders 8 & 9 are limited to 70cc or less.

Minimum safety equipment required: Helmet, goggles or shield, jeans, full shirt, and over the ankles boots.

ATV, PASSENGER, REGISTRATION AND INSURANCE MUST BE PRESENT !!!
